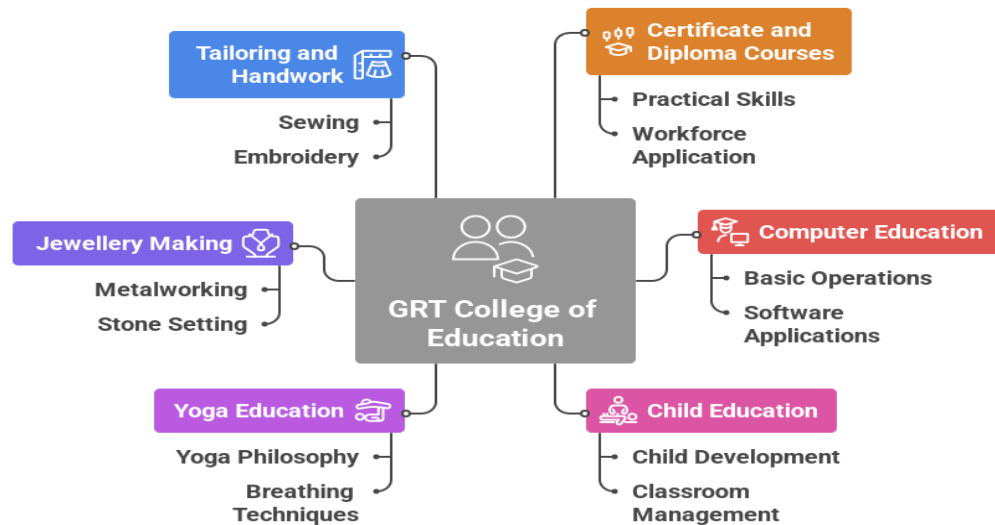


Vocational Education and Skill Development Initiatives
